

## APPLICATION FOR TUITION AND FEES EXEMPTION

Students who enroll in dual credit, early college high school, and/or early admission courses through McLennan Community College may be eligible for a tuition and fees exemption if the student is a resident of McLennan County, is enrolled at a McLennan County high school, OR if the course is taken on the McLennan campus or at a McLennan County high school. To apply, complete this form and return to the high school counselor or McLennan's dual credit office.

*The waiver does NOT cover textbooks, supplies, minimester courses, or special course/program fees.*

Family income eligibility is determined by the student's and/or parents' 2015 income, the number of people living in the household (including those away at college) and the number of people in the household attending college (for the same semester as the student requesting the exemption, including that student).

Using the chart below, you can expect to qualify for the exemption if your household income is at or below the income listed for the number in your household and number in college.
