Highlanders win Coca-Cola Classic

The McLennan Highlanders shot 291 to finish in first place at the Coca-Cola Classic, held at the par-72, 7,478-yard Twin Rivers Golf Club. The two-day event was shortened to one round this morning due to yesterday's weather conditions.

Texas-Arlington and New Mexico Community College finished tied for second with 297.

Freshman Tyler Russell led the Highlanders with 71 to finish tied for third. Medalist Lucas Morande of Hannibal-LaGrange won the individual title with 67.

Other MCC scores: Jeremy Lambright, tied for sixth, 72; Juan Salcedo, tied for ninth, 73; Nathan Anderson, tied for 19th, 75; John Neufeld, tied for 26th, 76; Dylan Anthony, tied for 26th, 76; Bryan Brennan, tied for 44th, 79; Kendall Magee, tied for 47th, 80; Jeff Hageman, tied for 47th, 80; and Aaron Musick, tied for 61st, 85.

Other team scores: Texas, fourth, 299; Western Texas, fifth, 300; Texas A&M, tied for sixth, 303; Paris, tied for sixth, 303; Baylor, tied for sixth, 303; Frank Phillips Gold, ninth, 308; Hutchinson, 10th, 309; McLennan Orange, 11th, 311; and Frank Phillips Blue, 12th, 326.

The Highlanders have won all four tournaments they entered this fall and are currently ranked first in the nation by Golfstat. MCC will compete in the Midland Invitational Nov. 1-2.
