

Activity Director

CLASS DESCRIPTION:

This class will provide the necessary information to prepare the student to be the key person for providing quality-of-life experiences for long-term care residents. The course includes an overview of the activity profession, adult human development, including the aging process, standards of practice, activity care planning for quality-of-life, methods of service delivery, activity management, human resources and treatment modalities. Several tasks will be required of the student during the course. These tasks relate directly to the activity director's job duties, and will be accomplished while in the nursing home environment as part of the Internship. The course consists of 215 hours, including 100 hours of classroom lecture, and 115 hours of Internship.

- High school diploma or GED

*student must have made arrangements with a long-term care facility in which 115 hours of internship will be gained during the course.
