

# Pharmacy Technician Review for Certification

## CLASS DESCRIPTION:

This class will provide the necessary information to prepare students to sit for the National Pharmacy Technician Certification Examination. Classes will review major topics covered on the National Pharmacy Technician Certification Examination; including (but not limited to) pharmacokinetics, drug names, drug interactions, dosages and possible side effects of drugs, pharmaceutical calculations, aseptic techniques, tasks/duties of pharmacists and pharmacy technicians, applicable pharmacy law, and ethics.

\*Tuition/fees include a background check, so that students may experience a pharmacy observation.
