The U. S. Department of Education has established requirements to help prevent fraud and abuse in the federal programs by identifying students with unusual enrollment patterns and indicating on the ISIR that these patterns exist. In order to resolve this issue, **you must provide an official copy of all prior college transcripts** to our Admissions Department for official evaluation. You will not be eligible for financial aid until this process has been completed.
