Hayley Lehoski: Education is her Passion

Waco native and Midway High School graduate Hayley Peacock Lehoski says today that education is her passion, and that passion was awakened during her years as a student at McLennan Community College.

Hayley graduated from Midway in 1996 and chose to attend MCC, she says, because it was close to home, had a great variety of classes and offered having a wonderful educational experience at MCC, an experience she says helped prepare her for future studies.

Hayley graduated from MCC in 1998 and went on to Texas A&M, where she received her Bachelor's degree in interdisciplinary studies with a focus on early childhood education. After graduation, she took a job teaching kindergarten in Austin, where she worked for three years until she met and married her husband, Daniel. Daniel's Air Force career immediately took the couple to Okinawa, Japan, where Hayley taught first grade at the American school on base. The couple's next assignment was in Newport News, Virginia, where she again taught kindergarten for three more years.

While in Virginia, Hayley completed her master's degree in curriculum, instruction and



assessment for grades K-12. She also taught English to refugees from Iraq, which she remembers as an eye-opening and rewarding experience.

Hayley and her husband currently live in a small town in New Mexico and she works as Student Services Coordinator at New Mexico State University-Alamagordo. She works with dual credit and transferring students and is an adjunct instructor in education for students who also want to be teachers.

Hayley recalls that some of her favorite classes at MCC were Dr. Mike White's history

"I wasn't into History back then, but he made the learning fun and enjoyable," she says.

"I feel strongly that my start in education at MCC was one of the best decisions I've made. It really set me on a good path to continue my educational goals. I look forward to visiting soon to see how the campus has

joined an exclusive group of colleges and universities to hold the title of All-Steinway School.


