Mr. Holt called the regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Dr. McKown introduced the guests present at the meeting.

Dr. McKown introduced Shawn Trochim, who introduced the baseball coaching staff. The Board recognized the baseball team.

Dr. McKown presented the following Consent Agenda Items for Board approval: 1) Consideration of and Approval of Minutes of June 29, 2017, and July 25, 2017; 2) Consideration of and Approval of Online Tutoring; 3) Consideration of and Approval of Revisions to the Bank Depository Policy (D-VI); 4) Consideration of and Approval of Revisions to the Investment of College Funds Policy (D-IX); and 6) Appointment of Personnel: Assistant Professor, Respiratory

Care Technology (Tenure Eligible); Project Director, Upward Bound; Assistant Professor, Computer Information Technology (Tenure Eligible); Assistant Professor, Associate Degree Nursing (Tenure Eligible) (Three Positions); Assistant Professor, Office Technology (Tenure Eligible); Senior Accountant; Success Coach; and Assistant Professor, Cosmetology (Tenure Eligible). Mr. Sheehy moved to approve the Consent Agenda Items as presented. Mr. McDurham seconded the motion, and it carried unanimously.

Dr. Benson presented the financial report for June 2017. (D.F. V—186)

Mr. Turman moved to approve the financial report for June 2017 as presented. Mr. Stinnett seconded the motion, and the motion carried unanimously.

Dr. Balmos introduced Dr. Bill Lockhart who presented the Teaching Moment Presentation. (D.F. V—187)

Dr. McKown introduced Jacob Fraire, who presented a legislative update. (D.F. V—188)

Dr. Balmos presented information regarding the appointment of Assistant Professor, Associate Degree Nursing (Tenure Eligible) and Assistant Professor, Respiratory Care Technology (Tenure Eligible). (D.F. V—189)

Ms. Chavez moved to approve the appointment of Dr. Amy Winslow as Assistant Professor, Associate Degree Nursing (Tenure Eligible). Mr. McDurham seconded the motion, and the motion carried unanimously.

Dr. McKown, along with Dr. Benson, continued the discussion of the proposed 2017-2018 General Fund and Capital Improvement Fund Budgets. (D.F. V—190)

The Board reviewed the resolution declaring the intent to raise McLennan County Junior College District property taxes for 2018 tax year to an amount in excess of the 2017 tax levy, calling, and setting the dates of public hearings to receive comments on the proposed increase and directing the publication of notices of the public hearings as required by law. Mr. Turman moved to adopt a resolution with the intent of raising the tax rate above the calculated effective tax rate but below the rollback rate. The intent being to set a rate in the regular board meeting in August at \$.150346 per \$100 property valuation. Mr. McDurham seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.
