

Massage Therapy Payment Options

Payment in full.

- Can be made at the MCC Business Office, over the phone with the Business Office, or on Webadvisor.

Payment installment plan.

- Can be signed up for on Webadvisor, at the MCC Business Office, or over the phone with the Business Office.
- Available for the full cost of the program or a balance.
- If the payment given on Webadvisor is more than the student can afford they need to contact the Business Office to see if they can get the payment amount lowered.

TPEG (Texas Public Education Grant)

- Completed TPEG application has to be turned into James Kubacak in the Financial Aid office.
- Based off of FAFSA information, so the FAFSA for the corresponding year has to be completed when the TPEG application is turned in.
- Awards a maximum of \$2000 for qualified students.

Student's bill must be paid in full, by any of the above options, by the first day of classes. Failure to do so will result in the student being dropped from the program for the semester. The only financial aid available for the program is the above mentioned TPEG. Students can view their bill and TPEG award amount on Webadvisor. Massage Therapy is a Continuing Education program, and as such follows the Continuing Education Workforce refund and payment guidelines. This means that if the student withdraws from the program anytime before the first day of class they will receive a full refund of whatever money they have paid for the program. If the student received TPEG aid that aid will be sent back to Financial Aid. If the student withdraws on the first or second day of class, they will received a refund of 70% of whatever they paid. If they received TPEG aid that award amount will be sent back to Financial Aid. If the student withdraws any time from the third day of class, to the last day of class, they will not receive any refund.
