HONORS STUDENTS

At the end of each long semester, students who achieve and maintain prescribed standards of scholarship shall be awarded special recognition by inclusion in the Honors and Distinguished Honors Lists. The Director of Records and Registration shall verify the Honors and Distinguished Honors Lists at the end of the fall and spring semesters. Students who achieve a 3.5 to 3.79 grade point average are named to the Honors List and students who achieve a 3.8 to 4.0 grade point average are named to the Distinguished Honors List. To be recognized for the Honors and Distinguished Honors Lists, a student must have completed 12 or more college level semester hours (excluding developmental courses).

HONORS GRADUATES

To receive special recognition as an honor graduate at the Commencement Exercises, a student must have completed 60 or more college level semester hours with a cumulative grade point average of 3.50 or better. Special recognition categories and the grade averages required for each are as follows:

4.00	Highest Honors
3.80 - 3.99	High Honors
3.50 - 3.79	Honors

Students who graduate with highest honors shall be presented a special award during the Commencement Exercises.
