Submit the completed application to the PTA program director.
- Documentation – Test scores that show college readiness in reading, mathematics, and writing, or proof of qualified exemption**
Submit to both the PTA program director and Highlander Central in the Enrollment Services Center.
- Documentation – Transcripts from all colleges where you have earned credit**
Official transcripts must be submitted to Highlander Central. Copies of unofficial transcripts from all colleges including MCC must be submitted to the PTA program director.
Please Note: It is the applicant's responsibility to submit updated transcripts to Highlander Central as additional courses are completed.
- Documentation – Physical Therapy Experience Form (one per setting)**
Verification of 40 hours of volunteer/work time in two different physical therapy settings should be documented and submitted to the PTA program director.
- Documentation – Two Basic Workplace Skills Assessment Forms**
One form **MUST** be from a Physical Therapist or Physical Therapist Assistant. Submit to the PTA program director.
- Documentation – Academic Pre-Requisite Course List**
Submit to the PTA program director.
